

**THE 2016 CALTRANS FUTURE IN TRANSPORTATION SCHOLARSHIP
AWARDED TO LODI HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATE**

Stockton – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) District 10 awarded the 2016 Future in Transportation Scholarship to Lodi High School graduate Brody Nutting.

Each year Caltrans District 10 provides a \$1,000 scholarship to a college-bound student living in the district who plans on pursuing a career in the transportation industry.

Nutting is scheduled to graduate from Lodi High School on May 31 with a 4.53 cumulative grade-point average. He was named the 2015 Tri-City Athletic League Student-Athlete of the Year, a member of the National Honor Society, and organized a fundraiser for victims of the recent 2015 Butte Fire disaster. Upon graduation, he plans to attend either U.C. Davis or Cal Poly-San Luis Obispo with the goal of earning his degree in mechanical engineering.

"I am extremely honored to be the winner of Caltrans Future in Transportation Scholarship," said Nutting. "Transportation, in all its forms, has always been a fascination of mine. I am extremely grateful to the scholarship committee and looking forward to using this money to further my education in engineering."
