



The environmental review, consultation, and any other action required in accordance with applicable Federal laws for this project is being, or has been, carried-out by Caltrans under its assumption of responsibility pursuant to 23 USC 326.

## Introduction

Section 4(f) of the Department of Transportation Act of 1966, codified in federal law as 49 United States Code (USC) 303, states “it is the policy of the United States Government that special effort should be made to preserve the natural beauty of the countryside and public park and recreation lands, wildlife and waterfowl refuges, and historic sites.”

Section 4(f) specifies that the Secretary (of Transportation) may approve a transportation program or project... requiring the use of publicly owned land of a public park, recreation area, or wildlife and waterfowl refuge of national, state, or local significance, or land of an historic site of national, state, or local significance (as determined by the federal, state, or local officials having jurisdiction over the park, area, refuge, or site) only if:

- there is no prudent and feasible alternative to using that land; and
- the program or project includes all possible planning to minimize harm to the park, recreation area, wildlife and waterfowl refuge, or historic site resulting from the use.

Section 4(f) further requires consultation with the Department of the Interior and, as appropriate, the involved offices of the Department of Agriculture and the Department of Housing and Urban Development in developing transportation projects and programs that use lands protected by Section 4(f). If historic sites are involved, then coordination with the State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO) is also needed.

### ***De Minimis***

Section 6009(a) of SAFETEA-LU amended Section 4(f) legislation at 23 USC 138 and 49 USC 303 to simplify the processing and approval of projects that have only *de minimis* impacts on lands protected by Section 4(f). This revision provides that once the U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT) determines that a transportation use of Section 4(f) property, after consideration of any impact avoidance, minimization, and mitigation or enhancement measures, results in a *de minimis* impact on that property, an analysis of avoidance alternatives is not required and the Section 4(f) evaluation process is complete. Federal Highway Administration’s (FHWA’s) final rule on Section 4(f) *de minimis* findings are codified in 23 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 774.3 and CFR 774.17.

Responsibility for compliance with Section 4(f) has been assigned to California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), pursuant to 23 USC 326 and 327, including determinations and approval of Section 4(f) evaluations, as well as coordination with those agencies that have jurisdiction over a Section 4(f) resource that may be affected by a project action.

## **Section 4(f) Proposed *De Minimis* Determination**

### **San Elijo Lagoon Ecological Reserve and Nature Center**

The San Elijo Lagoon Ecological Reserve (Reserve) is publically owned by the California Department of Fish and Wildlife (DFW) and County of San Diego and has the following officials with jurisdiction: DFW, County of San Diego, and the San Elijo Lagoon Conservancy. The Reserve is located between the Cities of Encinitas and Solana Beach and extends inland to the community of Rancho Santa Fe. The Reserve is bordered by the Pacific Ocean to the west, and a mix of residential and undeveloped land to the east, north, and south. The entire Reserve

is approximately 1,000 acres in size. It is primarily a shallow-water estuary fed by a 77-square-mile watershed with two main tributaries, Escondido Creek and Orilla Creek, and is divided into basins by Highway 101, the railway, and Interstate 5 (I-5). It contains a diverse habitat with six plant communities including coastal strand, salt marsh, freshwater marsh, riparian scrub, coastal sage scrub, and mixed chaparral. The habitat supports a variety of plant and wildlife species. Please see Appendix A for *Figure 1: San Elijo Lagoon Ecological Reserve Map*.

The Reserve is open to the public and visitor usage of the Reserve is estimated between 55,000 to 65,000 visitor use days per year (entry onto the Reserve is equal to one visitor use day). Visitors are primarily residents of the surrounding neighborhoods and jogging is popular along the southern trails. School field trips are held at the Nature Center. The park's status as a publicly-owned ecological Reserve and recreation area qualifies the Reserve as a resource subject to protection under Section 4(f) under the [Section 4\(f\) of the Department of Transportation Act \(§ 23 CFR 774 – Parks, Recreation Areas, Wildlife and Waterfowl Refuges, and Historic Sites \[Section 4\(f\)\] under authority 23 U.S.C. 103\(c\), 109\(h\), 138, 325, 326, 327 and 204\(h\)\(2\); 49 U.S.C. 303; Section 6009 of the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users \(Pub. L. 109-59, Aug. 10, 2005, 119 Stat. 1144\); 49 CFR 1.48 and 1.51.](#)

### **Description of Proposed Project**

Caltrans is proposing a change of right-of-way into a transportation use on a portion of the Reserve within the DFW and County of San Diego owned land. Specifically, Caltrans is proposing a total of five *de minimis* locations for both the construction and replacement of the proposed rock slope protection/armoring on the abutments of the San Elijo Lagoon Bridge, and the Manchester Avenue shared bike path with pedestrians with a roundabout crossing. This work is associated with the approved I-5 North Coast Corridor Project (I-5 NCC Project) or Express Lanes Project that will reconstruct the existing I-5 bridge crossing of the San Elijo Lagoon, with road work to Manchester Avenue to the east and west of the freeway, as well as, installation of a roundabout at the intersection of Manchester Avenue and San Elijo Lagoon Nature Center. Included with the proposed work is the installation of rock slope protection/armoring at several locations to protect the bridge abutments, and to shore up the roadway slope. At several locations the work (temporary and permanent) would extend slightly beyond the existing Caltrans property line. At the five locations identified as proposed *de minimis*, slivers of land is proposed to be deeded over to Caltrans to maintain the rock slope protection/armoring for Location 2 – 0.03 acre at edge of south-east abutment. The other four locations support the Manchester Avenue shared bike path with pedestrians with a roundabout crossing into a public road easement at Locations 7 – 0.11 acre, 9 – 0.06 acre, 10 – 0.02 acre, and 14 – 0.02 acre along Manchester Avenue, west of the I-5. (See Layout in Appendix A, *Figure 2: San Elijo Lagoon Ecological Reserve Proposed Right-of-Way Requirements*).

### **Impacts**

The potential impacts from the proposed work at the San Elijo Lagoon are within two basic areas. One area for the rock slope protection/armoring includes excavating the slope near the freeway at the south east abutment where there are no trails or evidence of human use. Soil will then be placed over this rock slope protection/armoring and revegetated with native plants that exist in the area. The other four areas are along Manchester Avenue to build a travel way for pedestrians and bicycles with protected crossing. *Figure 2: San Elijo Lagoon Ecological Reserve Proposed Right-of-Way Requirements* identifies additional temporary construction

easements that are proposed to allow room for construction equipment to pass over it. The observed current use on these four areas includes walking, bicycling, and parking for cars, which is not signed. The potential *de minimis* or permanent impacts to Reserve area are estimated at approximately 0.24 acres, which is about 0.024 percent of the total Reserve area (0.017% DFW land, and 0.007% County of San Diego land). (See Appendix A - *Figure 2: San Elijo Lagoon Ecological Reserve Proposed Right-of-Way Requirements* for a breakdown of the various locations.)

There are no anticipated changes to access, visual quality, vegetation, wildlife, air quality, or water quality, and it would remain similar to existing conditions. The roadway is moving closer to the San Elijo Lagoon; however, this small change would not result in a substantial increase in the noise but would remain similar to existing conditions, as no additional vehicle lanes are proposed.

This minor use would not impact any other trails or activity areas that are designated as part of the San Elijo Lagoon Reserve or Nature Center. Additionally, the undeveloped slivers of land do not possess any unique features or perform any vital functions that would be lost, but would support the Reserve's ability to function as a 4(f) resource.

#### Beneficial Aspects of proposed work

This proposed work supports the beneficial features within the lagoon that will be built with the Express Lanes Project (I-5 NCC Project). This slope will house an enhanced 12-foot wide decomposed granite trail with lodge pole fencing (east-west), which connects to other trails within the lagoon, ultimately connecting to the Manchester Avenue shared bike path with pedestrians. In addition, there will be an almost 400 foot-long suspended steel rail pedestrian bridge (south-north) that will directly connect to the enhanced decomposed granite trail around the south abutment (described above) to the Manchester Avenue shared bike path with pedestrians and roundabout crossing. This work will also support the North Coast Bike Trail.

Furthermore, this proposed work will have the following benefits:

#### Rock Slope Protection/Armoring for freeway support

The existing I-5 bridge is currently armored against scour and the replacement bridge will also have to be armored against scour consistent with Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) requirements. The federal standards for bridge protection that were used to determine the size and placement of armoring were based on FHWA's 2012 HEC-18 manual. The design was prepared using flood flow velocities from the prescribed 200 year event to predict scour depths at the abutment. The configuration of the armor section is a combination of armor size, slope, and depth to resist that erosion. The return distance, where the armoring wraps around the abutment, is also a function of the regulation and the scour velocity. The design was optimized assuming different slopes, armor size, and depth. Steeper slopes will require significantly larger armor stone but with nearly no change in footprint. The toe design was also optimized to consider construction scenarios, amount of stone, and toe depth. The perched toe that was selected uses an equivalent amount of stone as a continuous slope, with a similar size footprint, but limits the amount of excavation required to place the stone. The thickness of the section is a function of bedding layers needed to bridge the largest armor to the earthen bank. At San Elijo, design was able to limit the section to a 2 layer system aggregate base with the armor. Aggregate base is a

gradation of rock varying from the largest stone of 4-inches in diameter to silty material. Filter fabric will also be placed on the slope. The deepest/greatest scour will only be realized in the largest flood events so the design section of the perched toe could be covered with a foot or two of earth to allow a natural bottom that will be rapidly scoured under high flood flows. This could also be done on the return sections all the way to the top of the revetment.

The armoring could be placed at a 2:1 slope down to the scour depth of a 200 year event, which is at -31 feet. However, the decision was made to excavate at 2:1 down to -11 feet and then place a perched toe (pad of smaller rock) out to approximately the same distance as the 2:1 slope will require. This construction method requires much less excavation and provides the same protection. The rock will then be backfilled to the proposed channel depth, -4 feet NAVD88 within the channel. The same perched toe pad will extend around the southern abutment; however in this location the slope will be backfilled with more sediment to correspond the appropriate contours and appropriate habitats. The armoring will be completely buried and will be able to be revegetated with salt marsh species/transitional species following placement. The armoring will also be covered with soil above the tidal line where the wildlife bench and pedestrian crossing under the bridge will be constructed. Where sunlight is available (not directly under the bridge), the rock will be revegetated with native species.

The widened/optimized channel proposed for the I-5 Bridge to span is part of the San Elijo Lagoon Restoration Project that will restore tidal flushing well east of I-5 and restore wetland habitats throughout the lagoon. A wider channel that will carry more tidal as well as fluvial flows under the bridge is necessary and the armoring is necessary to protect the bridge structure. The middle of the channel will not be armored. The existing bridge abutments are currently armored and the replacement bridge must also be armored. The design chosen meets the required FHWA standards with reduced dredging required for placement, and it allows for the rock to be covered with some of the dredged sediment to recreate aquatic, intertidal, and upland habitats.

#### Manchester Avenue shared bike path with pedestrians

The bike path is expected to serve pedestrians, recreational cyclists, and bicycle commuters. Due to geographical constraints, the alignment of the bike path must travel along Manchester Avenue between I-5 and the San Elijo Joint Powers Authority (JPA) Water Reclamation Facility. This section of the bike path will also connect several pieces of an existing bike path network at the San Elijo Lagoon, the San Elijo Lagoon Nature Center, and a parking area east of I-5. The San Elijo Lagoon Conservancy also has plans to connect the bike path network to the coast via a rail crossing in the future. It is, therefore, anticipated that a large number and broad-spectrum of users will use this section of the bike path.

To accommodate the volume of users while providing protected and efficient facility, a two way, buffer-separated trail is proposed on the south side of Manchester Avenue. As the bike path continues west, it will cross Manchester Avenue and continue north through the JPA right of way.

### Roundabout for a north-to-south crossing

Due to the expected volume and types of users (bicycle, pedestrian, recreational, and community), an improved north-south crossing at the Manchester Avenue/JPA intersection is necessary. A roundabout crossing has several desirable operational characteristics for a street crossing and path. The elements of the roundabout crossing are visible in advance of the intersection itself, the roadway is narrowed, and vehicles are channelized into a path that forces speed reduction. A roundabout also provides shorter crossings for pedestrians. A signalized intersection has the largest footprint of all alternatives, and has some negative operational characteristics. The intersection will need to be widened to accommodate turn lanes to the JPA and San Elijo Lagoon Nature Center, which could cause speeds to actually increase. Therefore, a roundabout crossing with the smallest footprint and speed limit accommodations is the only alternative being considered.

### Why Resource is Proposed *De Minimis*

Caltrans asserts that the use of the Section 4(f) resource and any impacts associated with the proposed project would not adversely affect any of the activities, features, or attributes that qualify the property for protection under 4(f), and is *de minimis*. There are no anticipated changes to the access, visual quality, vegetation, wildlife, air quality, and water quality would remain similar to the existing conditions. The roadway is moving slightly closer to the San Elijo Lagoon; however, this small change will not result in a substantial increase in the noise level and would remain similar to existing conditions, as no additional traffic lanes are proposed. Overall, it is expected that the use of up to 0.24 acres of land within the San Elijo Lagoon would not adversely affect any of the activities, features, or attributes of the Reserve that qualify the resource for protection under Section 4(f) and is proposed as *de minimis*.

### Coordination

A letter seeking concurrence for the *de minimis* findings was sent on December 9, 2015 to the officials with jurisdiction over the San Elijo Lagoon Ecological Reserve, which include California Department of Fish and Wildlife, the Department of Parks and Recreation at the County of San Diego, and the San Elijo Lagoon Conservancy. This letter contains the information presented in this document.

### Avoidance, Minimization, and/or Mitigation Measures

The land is within both the DFW and County of San Diego-owned portion of the San Elijo Lagoon to be used for *de minimis* regarding the rock slope protection/armoring, Manchester Avenue shared bike path with pedestrians, and roundabout crossing into a public road easement. These designs were selected because they have the smallest footprint, and where possible, avoid, minimize, or mitigate any temporary impacts in order to restore the resource to the condition in which it existed prior to the project.

The proposed *de minimis* use will be coordinated with other activities in the San Elijo Lagoon to ensure the trails will remain accessible for use as much as possible. Note that any trails within Caltrans Right-of-Way and crossing under the I-5 is a secondary use of the land, which is not protected under Section 4(f); however, those trails will be accommodated during construction with detours and minimum closures.

No additional mitigation is required for this property.

### **Public Notification Process**

The appropriate environmental compliance document to seek project approval is an Environmental Re-evaluation under the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and an Environmental Re-Validation under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) for the Express Lanes Project (I-5 North Coast Corridor [NCC] Project). Typically, public review and comment is not required for projects that do not require public circulation such as a Re-evaluation or Re-Validation. However, this proposed project involves a potential *de minimis* use and the *de minimis* use requires public notice and opportunity to review and comment.

The public opportunity to comment is during the formal public notice process for at least 30 days from December 11<sup>th</sup>, 2015 to January 8<sup>th</sup>, 2016. The Notice of Availability (NOA) of the proposed *de minimis* determination is provided in Appendix B, is posted online, and is mailed to residents near the proposed *de minimis* locations (see Appendix C for distribution list of residents).


Upon completion of the public review and comment period, Caltrans will review all public comments and provide responses to those that are substantive. In addition, Caltrans is coordinating with the officials that have jurisdiction over the San Elijo Lagoon Reserve and Nature Center about the proposed *de minimis* areas. Once public comments are addressed and if approval from the officials with jurisdiction occurs, Caltrans will complete the determination process for these proposed *de minimis* areas.

### **Proposed *De Minimis* Finding**

Impacts associated with the proposed project for the five areas would not adversely affect any of the activities, features, or attributes that qualify the property for protection under 4(f), and is *de minimis*.



# NOTICE OF INTENT

## Caltrans to Adopt a U.S. Department of Transportation Act Section 4(f) De Minimis Finding for Impacts to San Elijo Lagoon Ecological Reserve



**WHAT'S BEING PLANNED?** Caltrans is proposing a change of right-of-way into a transportation use on five minor areas averaging 0.05 acres each of the San Elijo Lagoon Ecological Reserve within the County of San Diego. The right-of-way for transportation use is for the construction and replacement of the proposed rock slope protection/armoring, and for the Manchester Avenue shared bike path with pedestrians into a public road easement.

**WHY THIS PUBLIC NOTICE?** The proposed project is an action that is subject to the U.S. Department of Transportation Act of 1966. Section 4(f) of this legislation seeks to protect from transportation use of publicly owned parks and recreation areas, waterfowl and wildlife refuges, and historic sites considered to have national, state or local significance from impacts related to the "use" of these resources caused by transportation projects. The act includes a special provision to carry out this effort in 23 CFR 774.17, Section 4(f). The responsibility for Section 4(f) findings has been assigned by the U.S. Department of Transportation/Federal Highway administration to the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) under the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act – A Legacy for User (SAFETEA-LU) Act of 2005. Section 6009 of SAFETEA-LU allows determinations that certain uses of 4(f) land will have no adverse effect – de minimis – on the protected resource. If a "use" is identified of a Section 4(f) property, an assessment is made of the effects, and either avoidance, minimization, mitigation, or enhancement measures are established to lessen those effects. Section 6009(a) requires that a public notice and opportunity for review and comment be provided for projects that potentially have a de minimis impact before making a determination or finding about the change in land use.

**WHAT'S AVAILABLE FOR REVIEW:** A document has been prepared to support Caltrans' intent to determine a de minimis impact finding, and is available for public review and comment, which can be found at <http://www.dot.ca.gov/dist11/envir.htm>.

Public comments on the 4(f) de minimis finding will be accepted until **Friday, January 8, 2016**. Responses or replies to the public comments may not be required, depending on the substantive nature of the comments; however, all comments and responses will be considered and documented in the administrative record for the proposed project.
