INTERCHANGE RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT AT ALICIA PARKWAY NOW UNDERWAY

Irvine— A construction is underway in the Cities of Laguna Hills, Lake Forrest, and Mission Viejo for the Reconstruction of the Alicia Parkway Overcrossing including the installation of a overhead sign structure. The project limits are .3 miles north to .4 miles south of Alicia Parkway. The project will consist of grinding and grooving pavement and overlaying the ramps with hot mix rubberized asphalt. Nighttime ramp closures will be needed during the project. Closure and detour details will be posted. The project is scheduled to be completed in 90 working days.

The winning contract bid is \$1,400,000.

The contractor is Granite Construction of Vista California.
