## **NORTHBOUND I-5 ON RAMP CLOSURE AT OSO PARKWAY**

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close the northbound I-5 onramp at westbound Oso Parkway in the city of Mission Viejo effective midnight on Monday, September 14th, 2009. The closure will be in effect until midnight on **Monday, October 12th, 2009**. This ramp is scheduled to reopen to the motoring public on the morning of Tuesday, October 13<sup>th</sup>, 2009. Construction crews have placed changeable message signs to advise motorists of detours around this temporary closure.

This closure is due to continuing construction work on the \$14.3 million Oso Parkway Interchange Project which began on September 15, 2008, with an anticipated completion date of March 2010.

As always, to ensure the safety of workers and the traveling public, in a construction zone, please remember to “*slow for the cone zone*”, be alert, and proceed with caution.
