State Route 57 & State Route 91 Ramp Improvement Projects Lane reductions and full onramp closures scheduled

Irvine—The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has begun an onramp improvement project along the southbound SR-57 at Chapman Avenue onramp converting the Highway Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) to a metered lane in Fullerton, and the westbound onramp to SR-91 Lakeview Avenue, converting the one lane onramp to two lanes in Anaheim.

The scope of work includes the modification of signs and onramps. Lane reductions and two days of full onramp closures begin next week. Detours will be posted. The Construction project cost estimate is \$120,000 with completion by August of 2012.
