INTERSTATE 5 PAVEMENT RESTORATION PROJECT UNDERWAY FROM DANA POINT TO MISSION VIEJO

Irvine—The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will be closing various lanes nightly on Interstate 5 from postmile marker 6.8 in Dana Point to postmile marker 14.5 in Mission Viejo.

The project is part of regularly scheduled maintenance construction. Paving Slabs that have reached the end of their service life have to be removed and replaced to provide a smoother ride and reduce hazards to the motoring public.

The work is being done in the overnight hours from 10:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. during the week and 10:00 p.m. to 9:00 a.m. on the weekends; completion of this project will be in August 2012.

Changeable message signs and detour signage will be placed to direct motorists to the available detour routes.

The contractor is Granite Construction of Vista California.
