What is the current status of the California Aid to Airports Program (C.A.A.P.)?

Our grant programs were not suspended this year, and the 2009-10 suspension is no longer in effect.

As of July 1, 2012, we will begin accepting 2012-13 certifications and disbursement requests.

If you have received a Federal AIP grant, apply immediately for an [AIP Matching Grant](#) as funds are available. It is the Department's intent to change the matching rate from 2.5 percent to 5.0 percent effective May 24, 2012. Matching grants issued prior to May 24, 2012 will be matched at the current rate of 2.5 percent.
